The AKC Doberman standard lists ideal height for males at 26" to 28", weight should be proportionate, typically from 70# to 100#. Ideal height for females is 24" to 26" weight should be proportionate, typically from 50# to 80#. However, the sizes of both males and females can & do vary, some Dobs can be much larger than the standard.

Ears may be cropped:



Or they may be left natural/uncropped:



Sometimes they are cropped but do not stand:



Natural ears can also stick up!



Tails are usually docked, but some are left natural which is a thin, whip-like tail:



Colors: Dobermans can come in 4 colors that are allowed by the AKC: Black (pictured above);
Red:



Blue (dilution of black):



Fawn (dilution of red):



All of the above colors have sharply-defined rust/tan markings.

“White”/Albino: The breed also carries a gene for albinism which can produce “white” Dobses”:
