For purposes of the DPCA Parade of Rescues, we define a "Rescued Doberman" as a dog that finds itself homeless and is adopted, generally from a rescue organization or from a shelter. A stray that is found and kept by the finder would also be eligible as a Rescue. We feel this differs substantially from a dog purchased from a pet store or from a breeder, or re-homed by a breeder, regardless of the purchaser's or breeder's motivation because money paid to rescue organizations or shelters is used to rescue future dogs and does not profit a company or an individual.
